

Tips for finding a good video location

- Lighting
 - Don't position yourself with a big bright window behind you
 - Don't shine lamps directly at your face
 - Start dark then add light
 - Utilize computer screens, tablet screens, etc. to illuminate your face if you don't have other options
- Framing (How the shot is set up)
 - Leave a little space above your head
 - Record in landscape mode (not vertical)
 - With your group, consider how you want to be sitting. Do you want some people facing left/right/center?
 - Make sure your area is clean - take a picture without you in the frame. Did you leave anything out on the tables?
- Prioritize a good sound over good video if you have to choose!
